

Dear Planning Board & Chairman Fontaine,

I wanted to comment on something I believe is too little considered during projects such as these: water. For a long time, my concern has been where water for the project and its added community members will come from. This concern was assuaged after reading Silo Ridge's final plan, which was submitted back in February.

Thanks to strong conservation measures, Silo Ridge's water usage will have no impact on surrounding properties and will be fully supplied with three on-site wells. Additionally, wastewater generated on the Silo Ridge property will be wholly treated by a new treatment plant. Even better, the total wastewater generation from the project will be reduced by 40% from the project's initial projections. In simpler terms, the project will generate less wastewater than initially projected and it will not burden the community when it comes to getting water or getting rid of it.

Therefore, I believe it is time to move this project forward. Our concerns have been met and the added benefits are just too great. It's time we build Silo Ridge.
