





Rebuilding Together Dutchess County's Home Safety and Fire Prevention program includes the installation of smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, fire extinguishers, motion-activated solar lights, LED light bulbs, and reflective house numbers alongside fire preparedness education. The installation takes approximately one hour with a team of volunteers and is completely **free of cost** to eligible homeowners in Dutchess County.



smoke alarms

10 years is too old! Even if hardwired, smoke alarms older than 10 years are ineffective in alerting you of a fire. RT Dutchess installs alarms with 10-year lithium batteries that last the life of the alarm on each floor and in the immediate vicinity of each bedroom.




co alarms

Carbon monoxide is a heavier gas. Alarms should sit lower to the ground to be most effective. RT Dutchess installs alarms with 10-year lithium batteries that last the life of the alarm on each floor.



fire extinguishers

RT Dutchess installs ABC fire extinguishers in an easy access location near an exit route. Remember P.A.S.S. - pull, aim, squeeze, sweep.



motion-activated solar light

RT Dutchess installs motion-activated solar security lights on the exterior of the home to assure safe, illuminated entry and exit.



LED light bulbs

RT Dutchess installs energy-efficient LED light bulbs throughout the interior of the home, which have a life of 22+ years and save approx. \$137 in annual energy costs per bulb.



reflective house numbers

RT Dutchess installs reflective house numbers to help first responders better identify the home in the case of an emergency.
