RE: SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE RESULTS OF A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR REGIONAL AMBULANCE SERVICES

WHEREAS, emergency medical care for the sick and injured is an essential service to the residents and visitors of any community; and

WHEREAS, the Towns of Amenia, Dover and North East, and the Village of Millerton were awarded funds through the 2017 Dutchess County Municipal Innovation Grant (MIG) program to evaluate current operations and make recommendations relative to contracting out separately for ambulance services versus joining forces to collaborate on a regional delivery of service; and

WHEREAS, the Towns of Amenia, Dover and North East, and the Village of Millerton had an ambulance services feasibility study conducted by CRG, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Amenia believes it is in the best interest of the Town, its residents and the other involved municipalities to conduct a Public Hearing to introduce the results of the ambulance services feasibility study and to address any questions or concerns with respect to the results of said study; now, therefore, be it
