**Resolution # 72 of 2018**

**RE: AWARDING BID FOR REPLACEMENT OF WELL LOCATED AT OLD AMENIA LANDFILL**

**WHEREAS**, a monitoring well located at the Old Amenia Landfill was destroyed by a tree falling on it and is in need of replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board authorized PVE, LLC to solicit for written quotes from qualified contractors in accordance with the Town of Amenia Procurement Policy for the replacement of the destroyed well at Old Amenia Landfill; and

**WHEREAS**, PVE, LLC received the following three written quotes:

Parratt-Wolff, Inc., East Syracuse, NY	\$6,215.00
North Star Drilling, Homer, NY	\$6,260.00
ADT, Mineloa, NY	\$11,850.00

**WHEREAS**, PVE, LLC has recommended awarding a contract to Parratt-Wolff, Inc., East Syracuse, New York; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the lowest responsible bid quote was from Parratt-Wolff, Inc., East Syracuse, NY, with a written quote in the amount of \$6,215.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this action is considered a Type II action for purposes of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(2), (the replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site) and, pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(18), (information collection including basic data collection and research, water quality and pollution studies, traffic counts, engineering studies, subsurface investigations and soil studies that do not commit the agency to undertake, fund or approve any Type I or Unlisted action); now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Amenia hereby awards the bid for the replacement of destroyed well located at Old Amenia Landfill to Parratt-Wolff, Inc., East Syracuse, NY, in the bid amount of \$6,215.00; and, be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the Town Supervisor to execute any contract documents, upon approval of the Attorney to the Town, and the contractor has supplied the necessary insurance certificates.
